SYNOPSIS

Alan Baker is an Associate with URS. In recent years he has been responsible for the design and contract preparation of structural schemes in the UK and abroad, and project manager for roads and bridges contracts in Central Scotland.

He joined URS after graduating from the University of Glasgow and became involved in a wide range of structural and roadworks projects, concrete and steel bridges, tunnels, water retaining structures, jetties and aqueducts, and proposals for structures and roadworks in Hong Kong, West Africa and the Middle East. He has assisted in the site supervision of a major motorway contract in Central Scotland, been Resident Engineer for a helicopter hangar extension in Shetland, and on an offshore oil production platform. In addition, he has worked in West Africa and Hong Kong on the survey and final design of roads contracts. He has supervised the design of multi-span elevated viaducts in Hong Kong, and was responsible for the design of all bridges on the M74 Motorway in Dumfries and Galloway. Subsequently he prepared the contract documentation for all new works associated with the M6 DBFO Project for upgrading the remainder of the A74 to motorway standard.

He has worked on proposals for the restoration of the Forth and Clyde, and Union Canals and was responsible for the design of all bridgeworks on the A96 Blackburn / Kintore Bypass near Aberdeen. He has undertaken structural investigations in Glasgow Schools, and bridge inspections and assessments for many Local Authorities in Scotland. He has assisted in proposals to re-open the Borders Railway and the Stirling - Alloa - Kincardine Railway in Scotland, and has worked on the upgrading of the West Coast Main Line, Trent Valley section, for Network Rail.
