Synopsis

Jim McCafferty is Chairman of Scott Wilson Scotland, and Ireland.

Jim joined the firm in 1967 following graduation from Strathclyde and has been a Director since 1987.

His early experience was on the design & construction of urban motorways in Glasgow but he transferred to Hong Kong in 1976 with responsibility for major projects in new towns, urban infrastructure, highways and bridges. Jim returned to Scotland in 1981 to manage the design of urban infrastructure for Nigeria's New Federal Capital Abuja.

Since 1981, Jim has been responsible for a broad range of infrastructure projects including:-

Hundreds of bridges in various materials; building structures; development planning; structural investigation and repair; expert advice; expert witness; bridge inspections and strengthening; Design Build and DBFO projects as designer, client's agent and Engineer on road, rail, port and airport projects; various military projects; project management of a wide range of buildings, industrial and retail projects; urban infrastructure and development of the firm's expertise in environment, planning, landscape and wind engineering.

He has presented papers and given talks on a wide range of subjects and many of his projects have won awards and commendations.

Jim is active in Institution and professional matters, notably The Institution of Civil Engineers, The Association of Consulting Engineers, The Scottish Council for Development & Industry and the Saltire Awards for Civil Engineering.
