Stuart McDougall, a classmate of mine at Strathclyde, joined Scott Wilson Glasgow in the summer of 1967. Stuart was a scratch golfer and an asset to any team. He moved to Strathclyde Regional Council on 'Regionalisation' but later moved on to the McCormack organisation and spent his life in golf and sport events and promotions.

Willard Dougal was responsible for the Glasgow Roads section becoming an Associate in the late 1970s. Willard, with George Baillie [also a Scott Wilson Glasgow man] set up Dougal Baillie & Partners in the early 1980s.

JM [Don] Breakey was responsible for drainage and other roads related matters. He became a Director of Scott Wilson Kirkpatrick & Co Scotland Ltd in the late 1970s but moved on shortly after to Strathclyde Regional Council and, ultimately to Jamieson McKay & Partners, joining Roy Hodgen, Jack Wood and Chris Ford, who had joined JMP earlier in the 1970s.
