Synopsis

Alistair Napier has been with Scott Wilson since graduating in 1977 and is currently a Director in Scotland with responsibility for Project Management and Building Structure Projects.

His early experience was gained in the Transportation division where he worked on the design of various rural and urban road schemes. He later joined the Structures Division where he worked on projects involving the design and detailing of various steelwork, reinforced concrete and masonry buildings, including various multi-storey developments.

In 1980 he was appointed as Assistant Resident Engineer for the construction of the Dhekalia 'B' power station in Cyprus where his particular responsibility was for the main building structures.

On completion in Cyprus, he transferred to the SWK (Oman) design office where he spent five years employed in the planning, design and construction of varied civil and structural engineering projects, with responsibility for project management and co-ordination of multi-disciplinary consultancy design teams. This work included projects for large commercial and military clients.

In 1986 he joined SWK Scotland and was subsequently appointed as Regional Managing Engineer of the Edinburgh design office in 1987. He became an Associate in 1994 and was promoted to Director in 1997. During this time he has been involved in and responsible for the design and investigation of commercial and military buildings structures and infrastructure and site development projects.

He is the Director responsible for the Building Structures Projects undertaken by the Firm in Scotland. Recent and current projects include a broad mix of Industrial, Operational, Retail, Office and Residential facilities for a range of Private and Public Sector Clients.
