Synopsis

Alistair Napier has been with Scott Wilson since graduating in 1977 and is currently a Director in Scotland with responsibility for Project Management and Building Structures Projects.

His early experience was gained in the Structures Section of the Basingstoke office where he worked on the design and detailing of various steelwork, reinforced concrete and masonry buildings, including various multi-storey developments.

In 1980 he was appointed as Assistant Resident Engineer for the construction of the Dhekelia 'B' power station in Cyprus.

On completion of his 24 months tour in Cyprus, he transferred to the SWK (Oman) design office where he spent five years employed in the planning, design and construction of varied civil and structural engineering projects, with responsibility for project management and co-ordination of multi-disciplinary consultancy design teams. This work included projects for large commercial and military clients.

In 1986 he joined Scott Wilson and was subsequently appointed as Regional Managing Engineer of the Edinburgh design office in 1987. He became an Associate in 1994 and was promoted to Director in 1997. During this time he has since been involved in and responsible for the design and investigation of commercial and military buildings structures and infrastructure and site development projects.

A particular area of responsibility has been for Project Management, with assembly of multi-disciplinary teams, for the design of commercial and public sector developments and for multi-disciplinary Advisory commissions. He is currently the Director for a Partnering Agreement for Defence Estates in Scotland for the provision of Advisory Services, Project Management and Design of Defence Projects for establishments throughout Scotland.
